Prior to joining the Port in 1987, he was the deputy director of engineering management in the NYC DOT Bureau of Ferries and General Operations overseeing a four-year, \$90 million capital and expense program and assistant director of the Westway Expediting Council.

Dinkels received his bachelor's design in civil engineering from the City College of New York. He is a licensed professional engineer in New York.
