In an effort to seat a growing number of students, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) contracted STV to provide design, construction documents, and construction support for the addition of 30 classrooms, a new gymnasium, and a library for this 2,400-student joint middle school and high school in Los Angeles, CA.

Additions total about 80,000 sf and consist of a 2-story classroom building, a single-story gymnasium, and a library and maintenance building. STV also provided design for remodel-

ing the existing central kitchen, as well as adding a new track and soccer field to the existing fields. Sustainable design/CHPS (similar to LEED design) was incorporated into STV's design.

Challenges included incorporating new high school programs within an operational middle school environment, and developing phasing plans to construct the additions and renovations with minimal impacts to school activities.
