Pressler received his Bachelor of Science degree from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, and his master’s degree in civil engineering/construction management from Stanford University. He also completed a post-masters degree in civil/environmental engineering from Stanford University. Pressler is a member of the Building Trade Employers Association, the Building Contractors Association, and is a co-chairman of the New York Building Congress Public Buildings SubCommittee.
